DRESS CODE

All female students MUST wear leotards and the proper shoes to rehearsal. (Hip Hop students do not need to wear leotards.) Hair must be pulled back and away from the face, preferably in a bun. **No sweatshirts, tank tops, or oversized clothing is permitted.** Students may wear any style or color leotards and bike shorts, or ballet skirts may be worn. Male students must wear sweatpants and T-shirts with the proper shoes. Please label your child's clothing, bags, etc. this keeps confusion to a minimum. *Remember:* most dance shoes look alike and MGSD is not responsible for lost items. Labeling your child's possessions will leave no doubt as to what belongs to whom.
